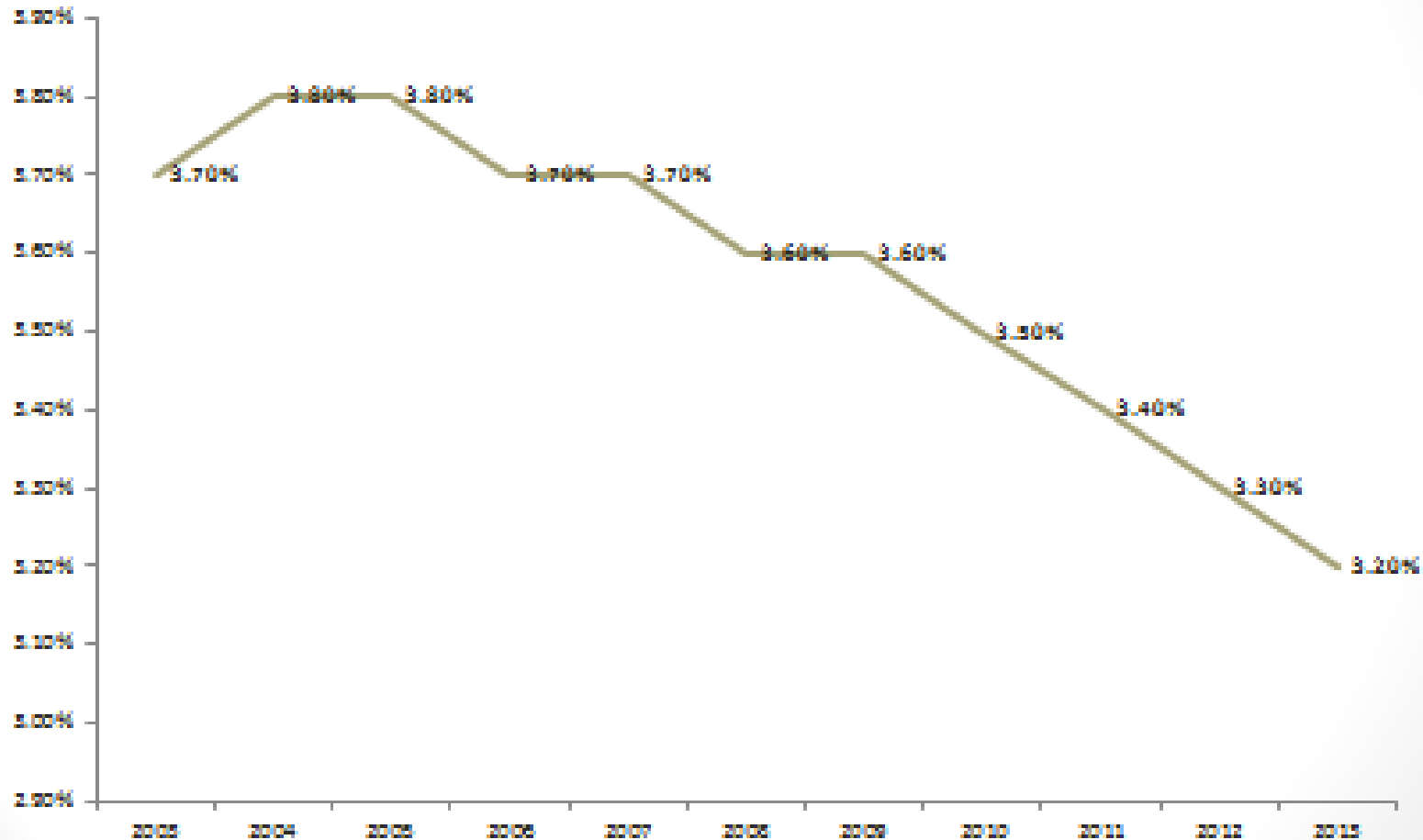


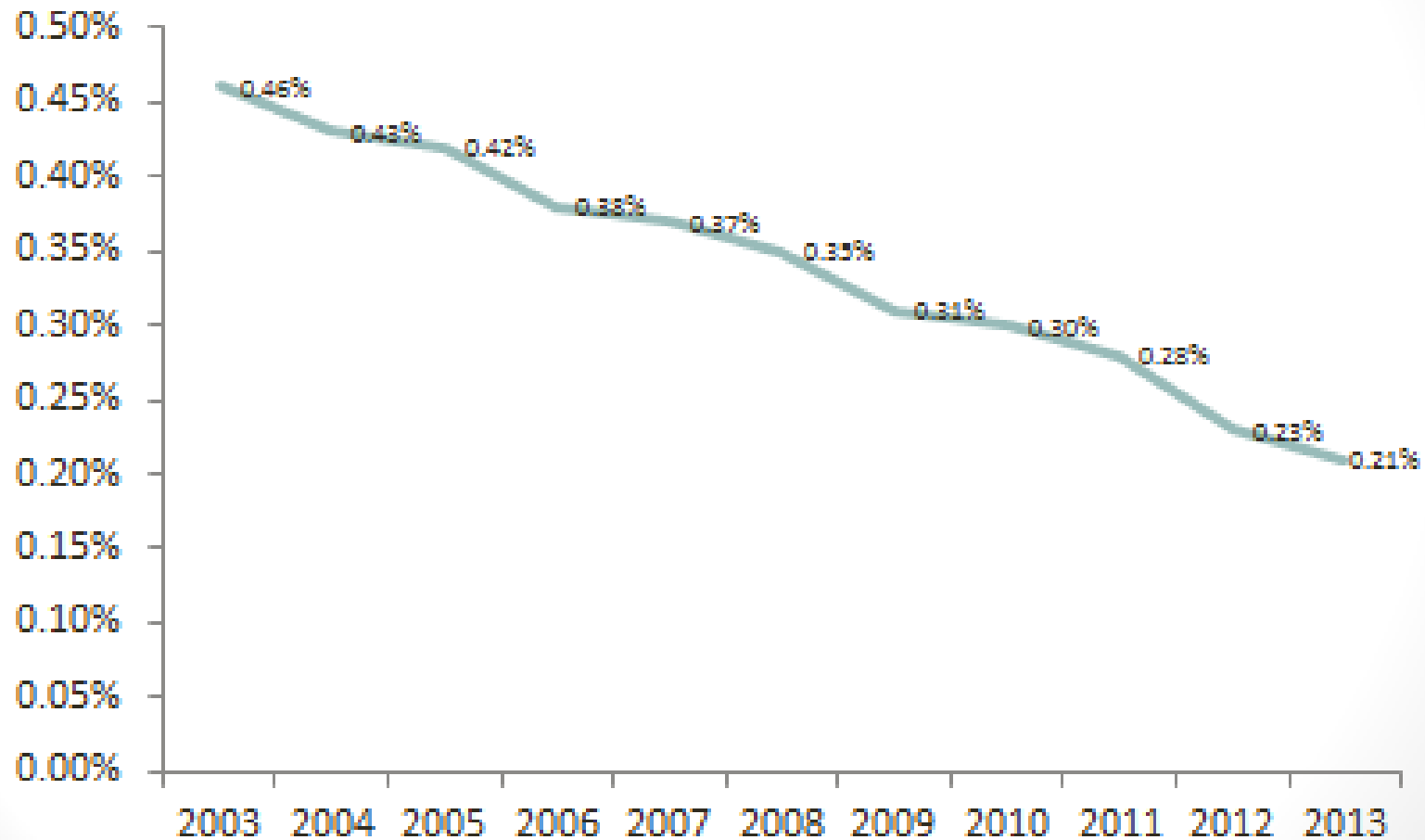

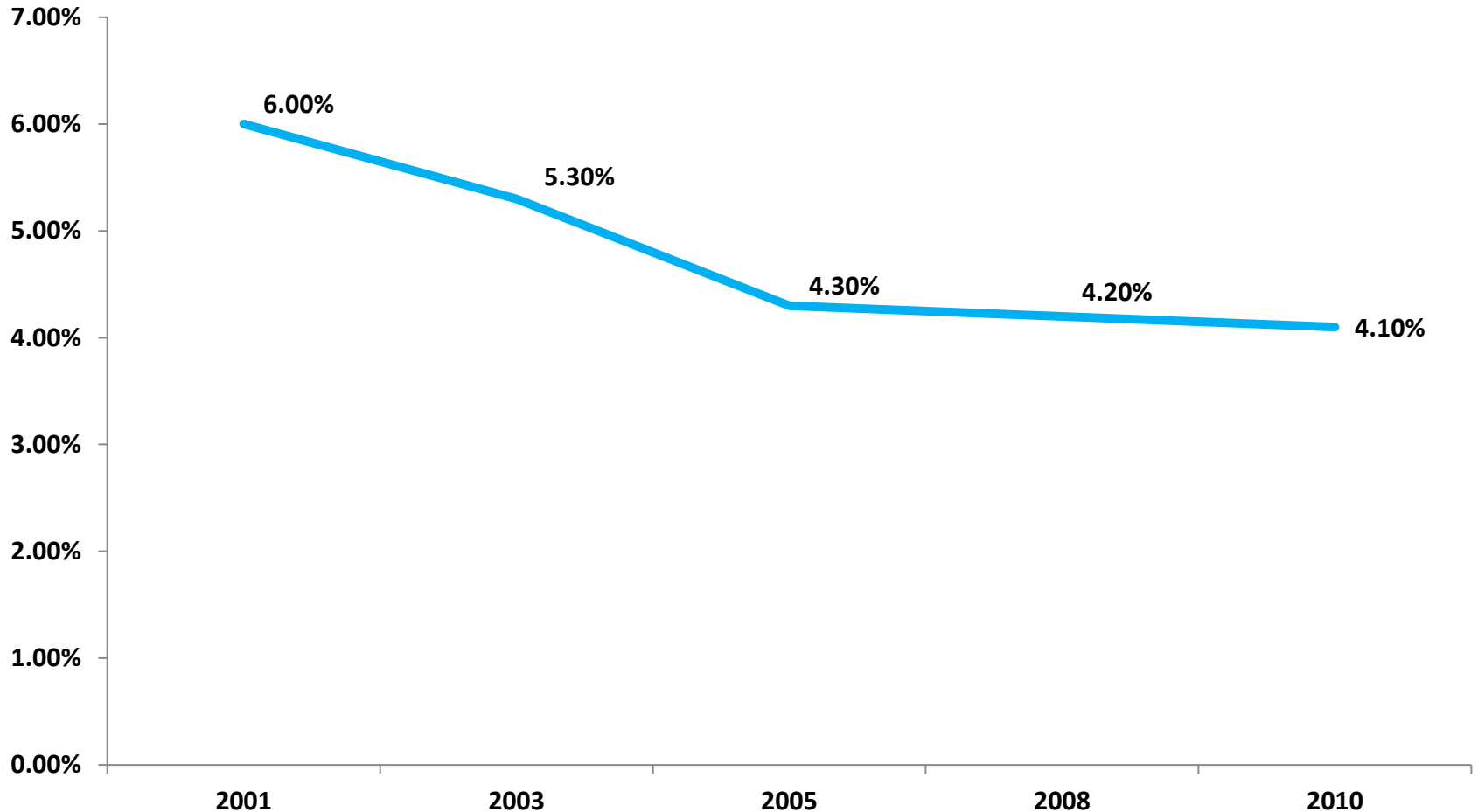
Estimated Adult HIV Prevalence : 2003-2013 (Spectrum 2013)



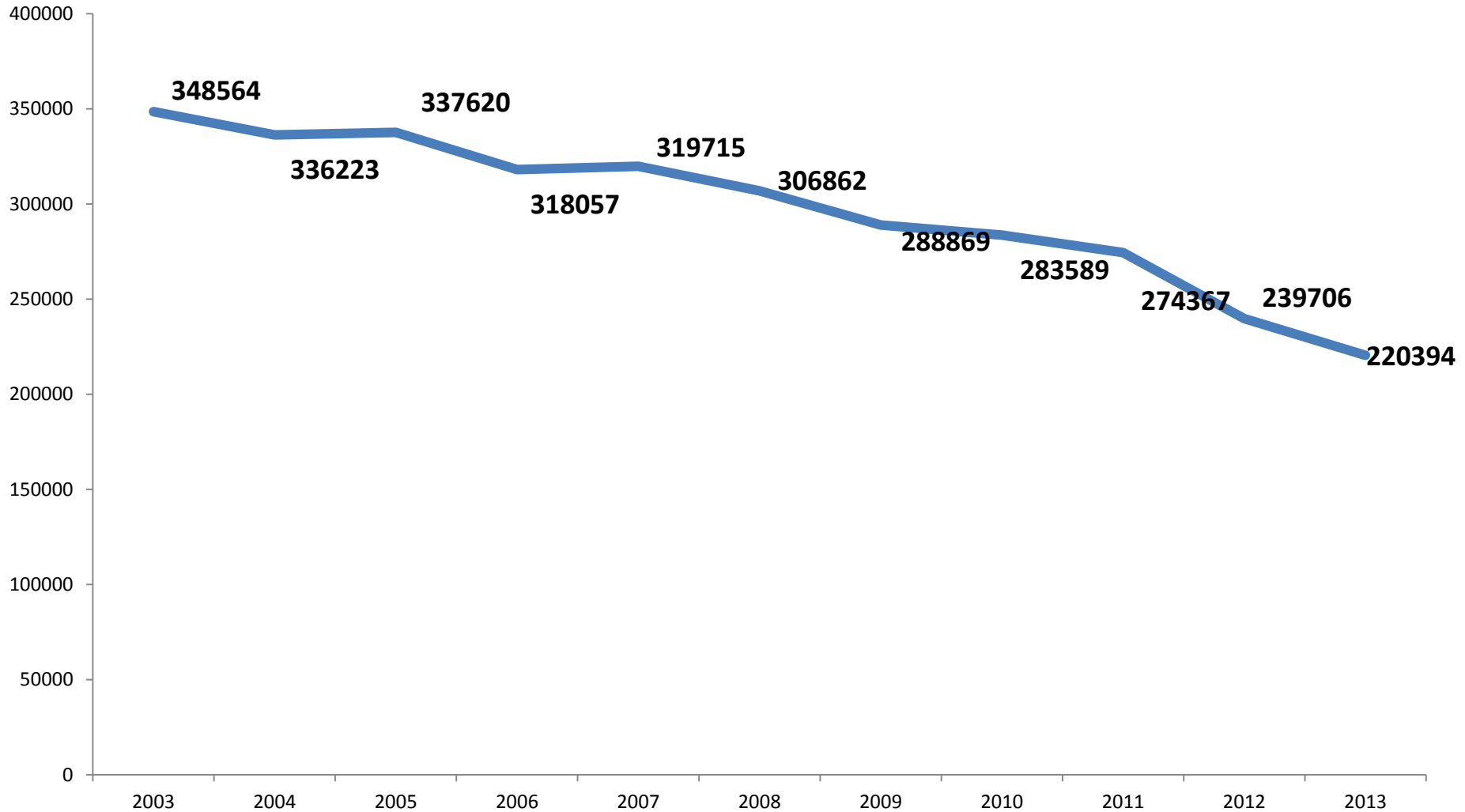
Estimated Incidence of HIV in Nigeria: 2003-2013: a 54% reduction



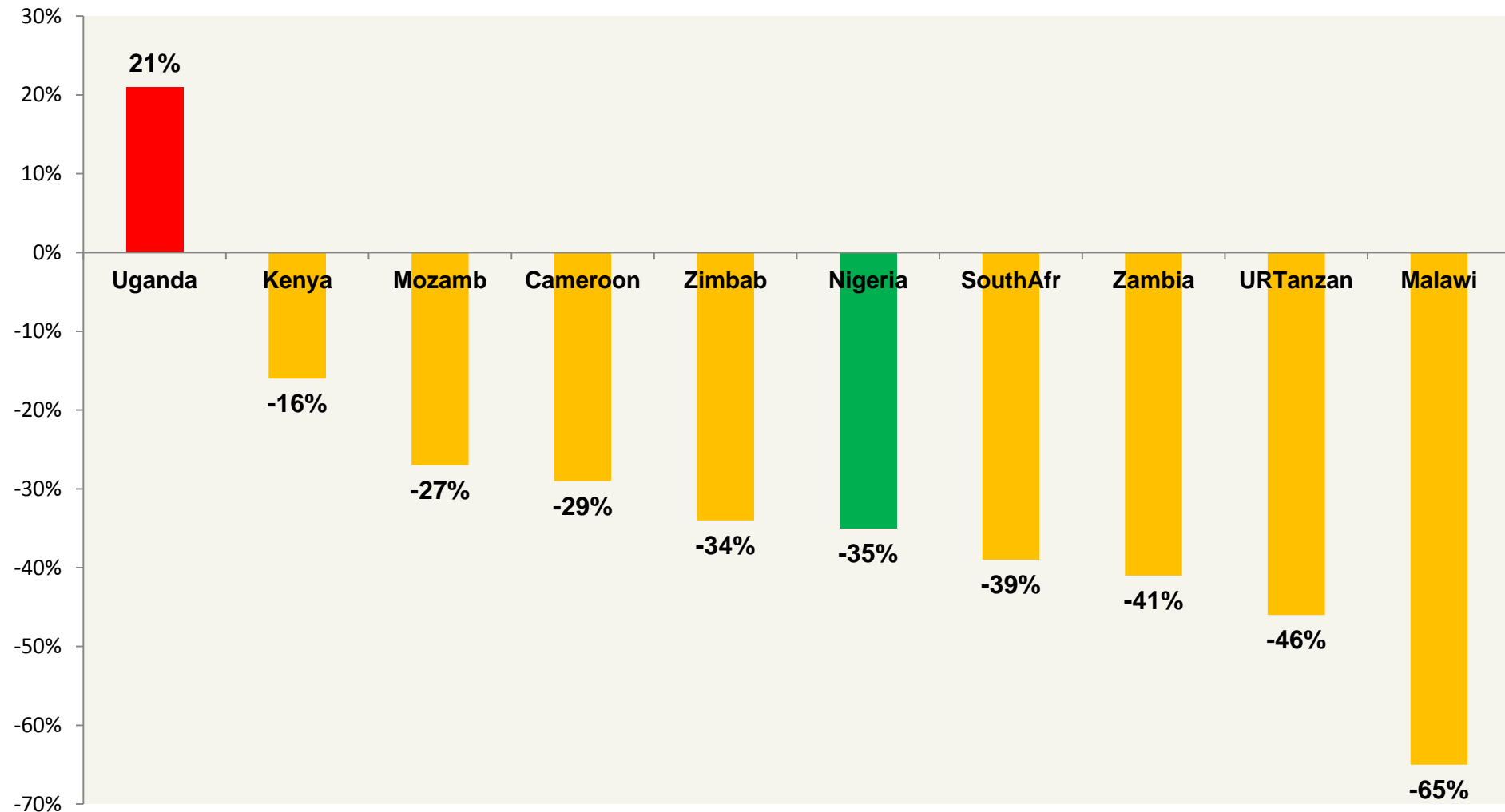
HIV Prevalence Among Pregnant Women 15-24 Years-Old. HSS.2010 : 33.3% reduction



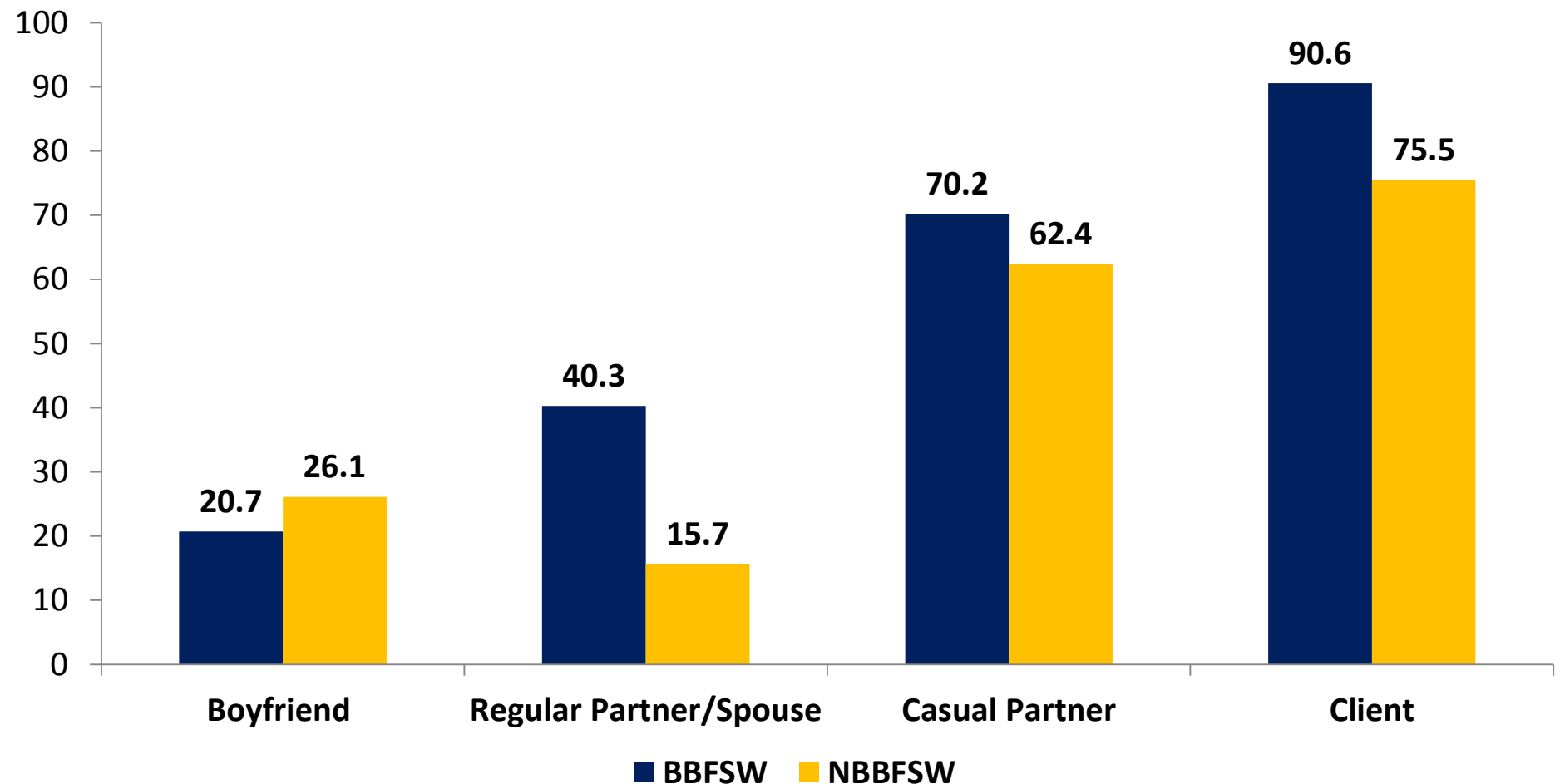
Decreasing New HIV Infections in Nigeria 2003-2013: 37% Reduction in New infections



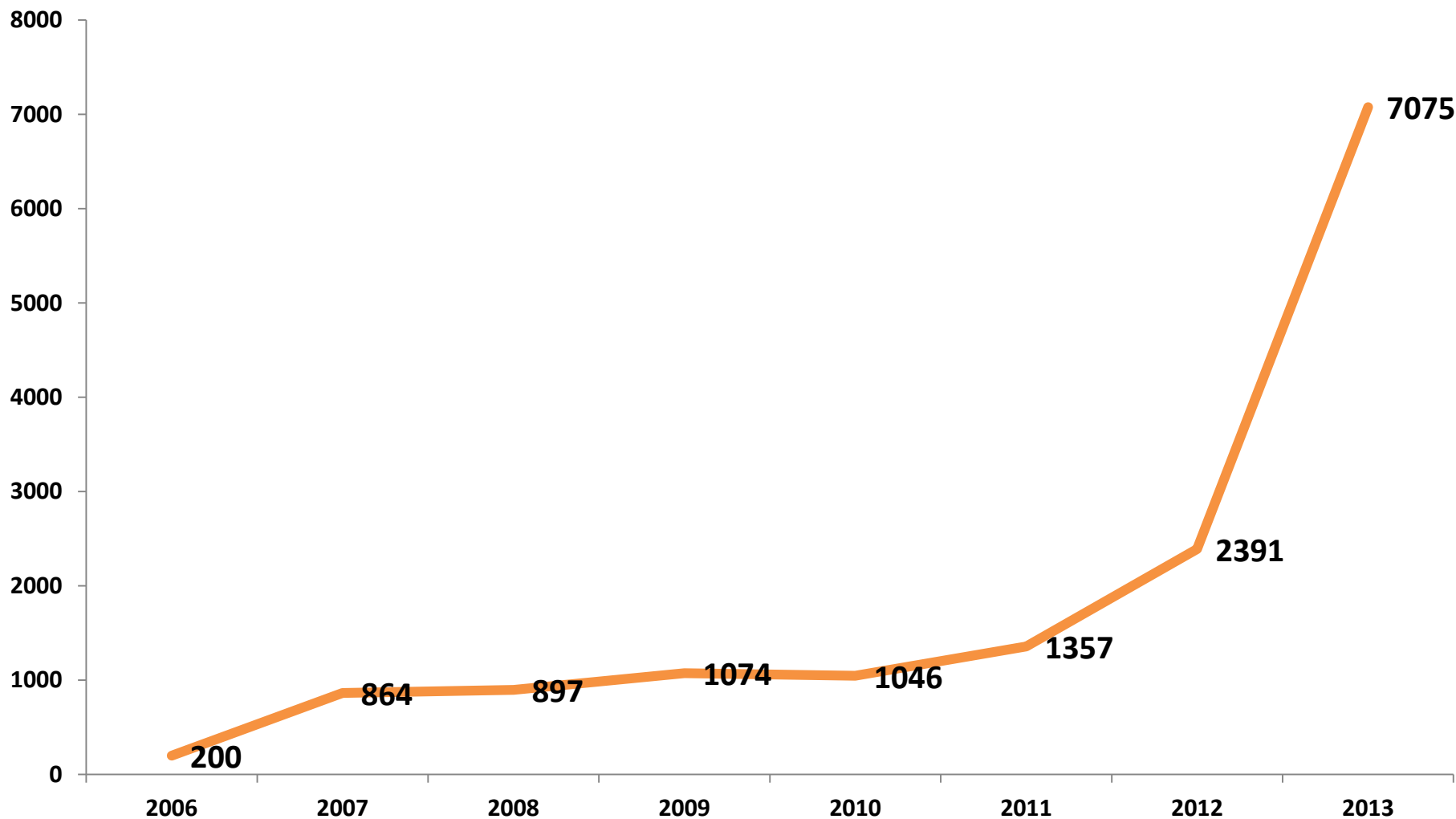
Trends in New HIV Infections for Top 10 Countries in Sub-Saharan Africa: 2005-2013 (UNAIDS-2014)



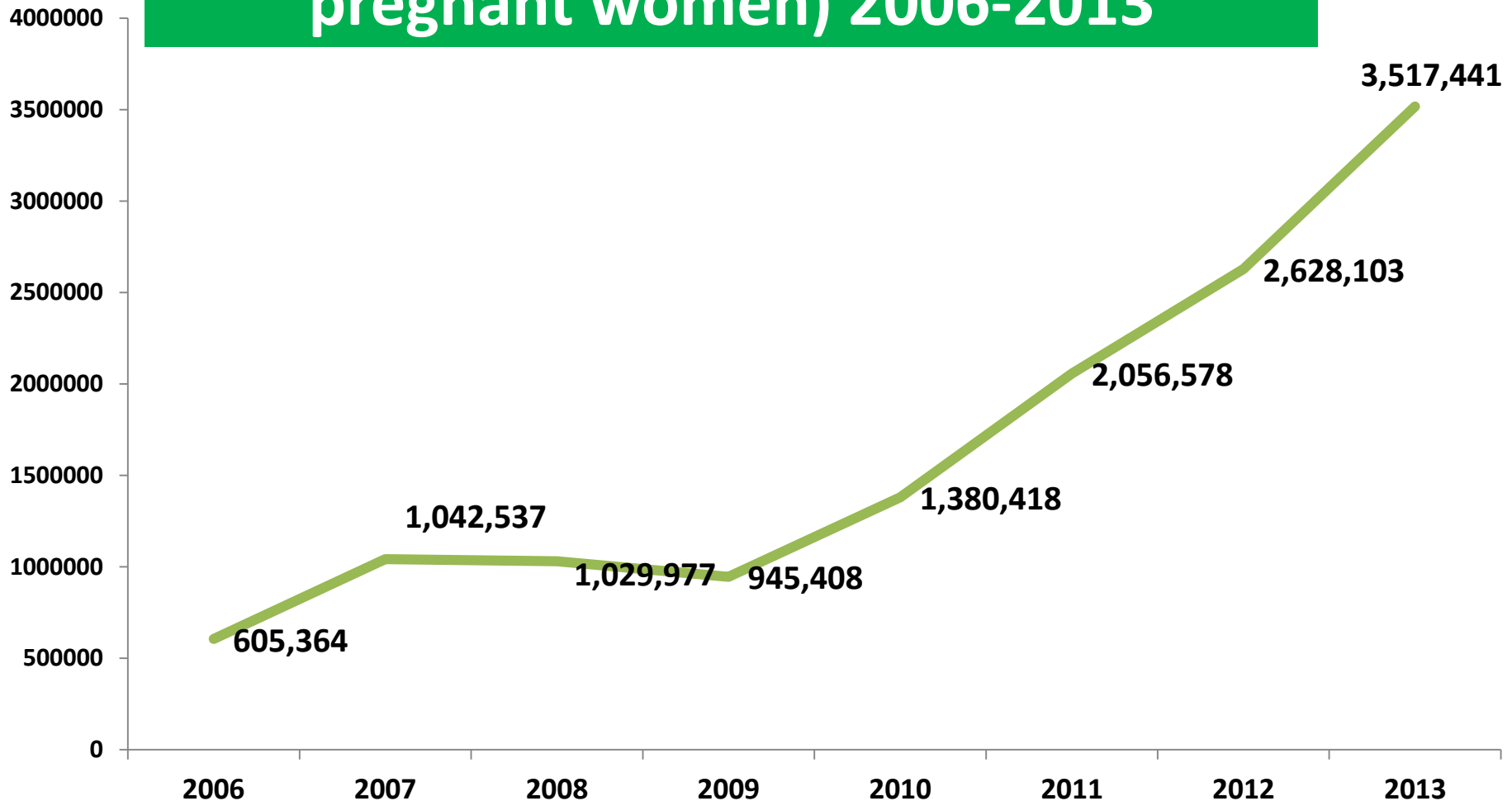
Consistent Condom Use by Female Sex Workers and their sex partners



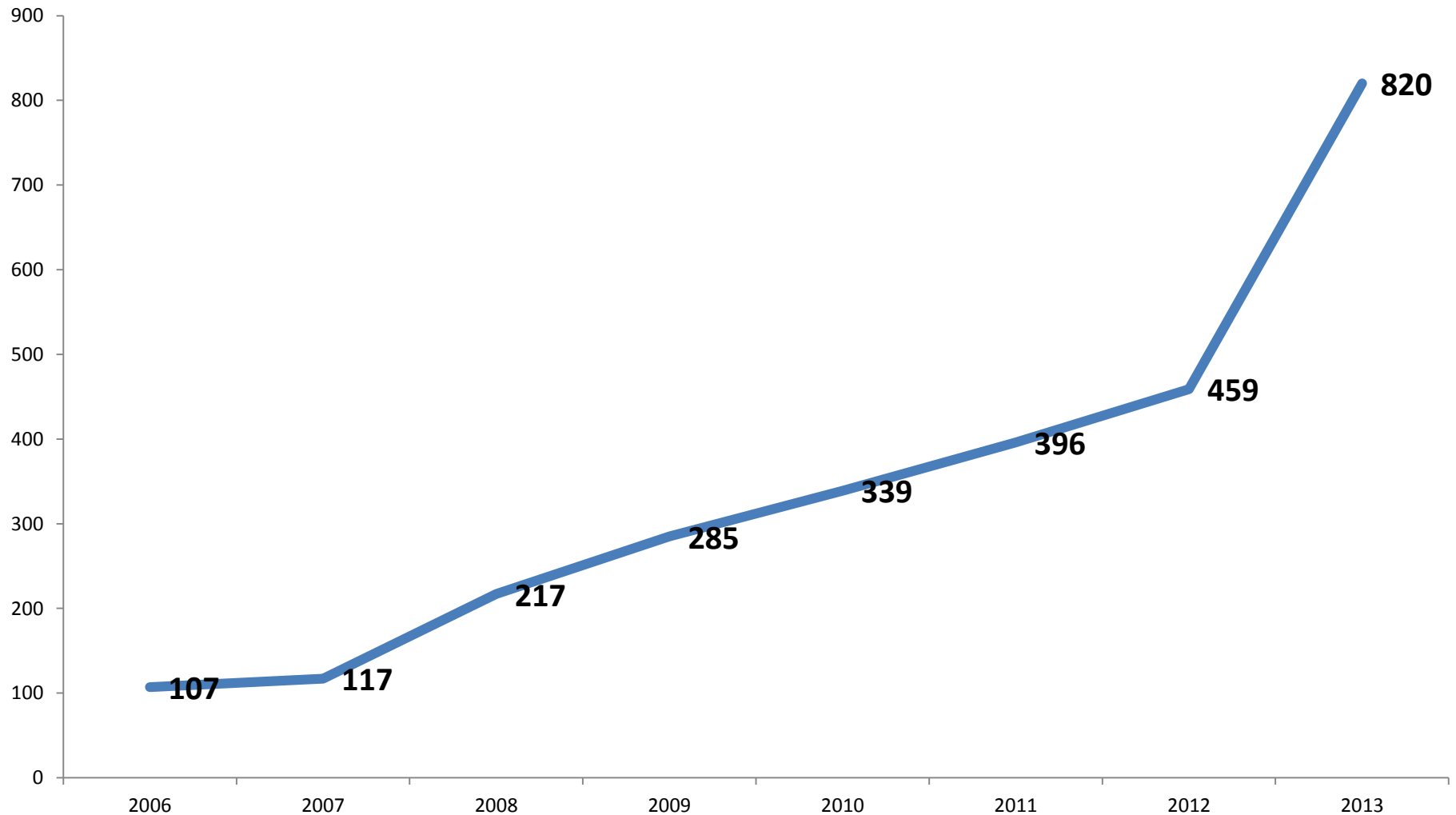
Number of HIV Counseling and Testing Sites in Nigeria: 2006-2013



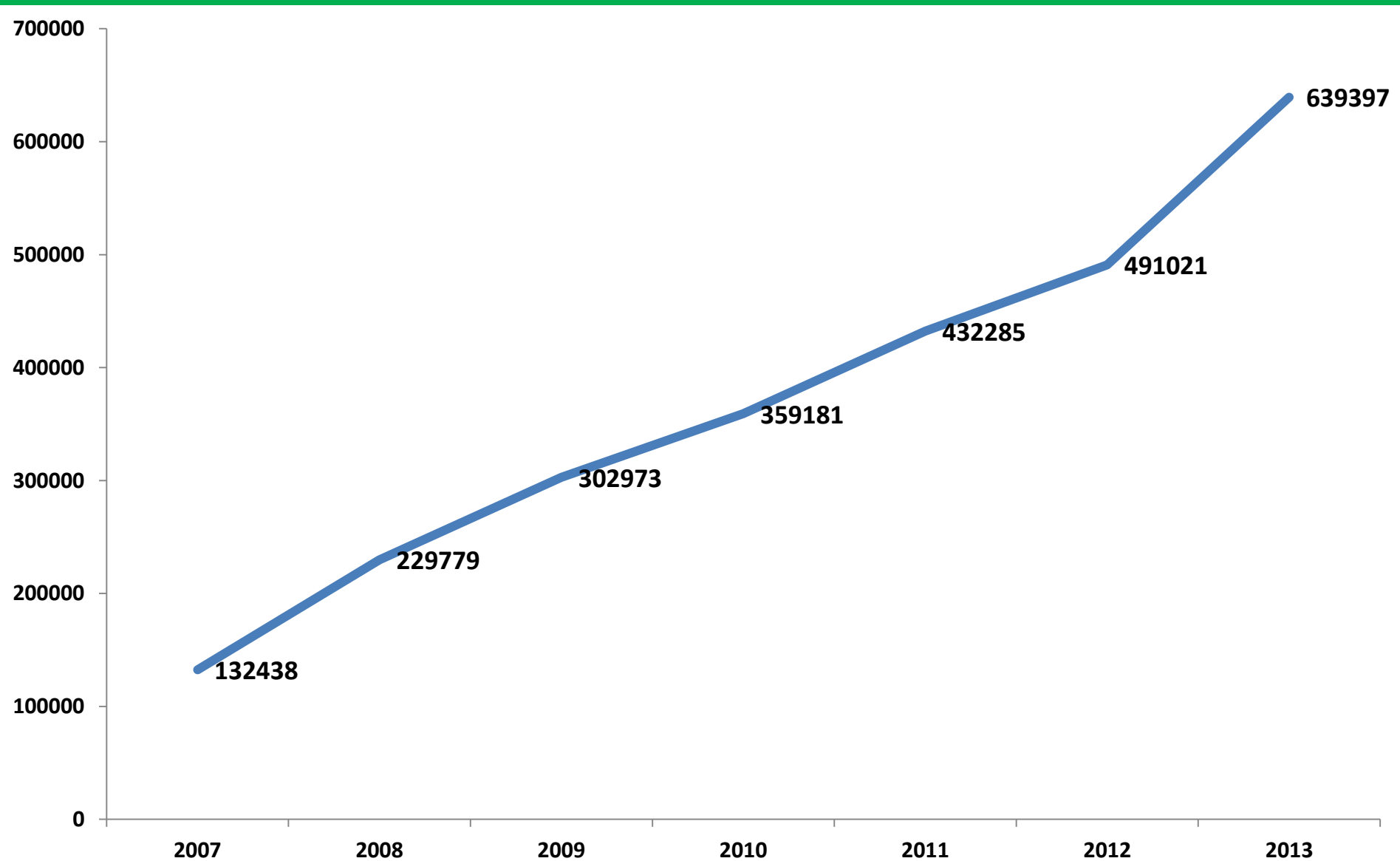
Number of people aged 15 + counseled, tested and received results (excluding pregnant women) 2006-2013



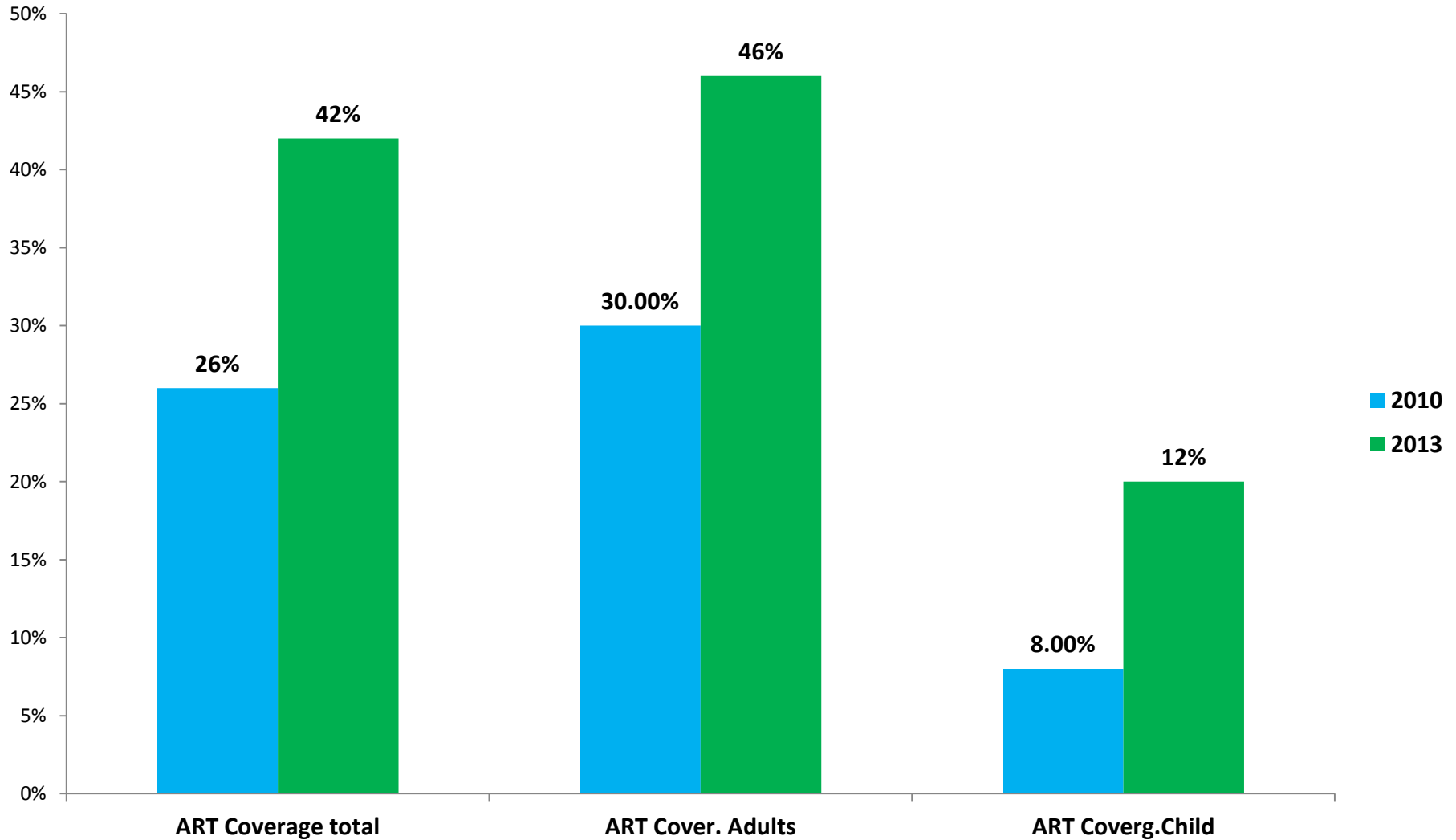
Number of ART Sites in Nigeria 2006-2013



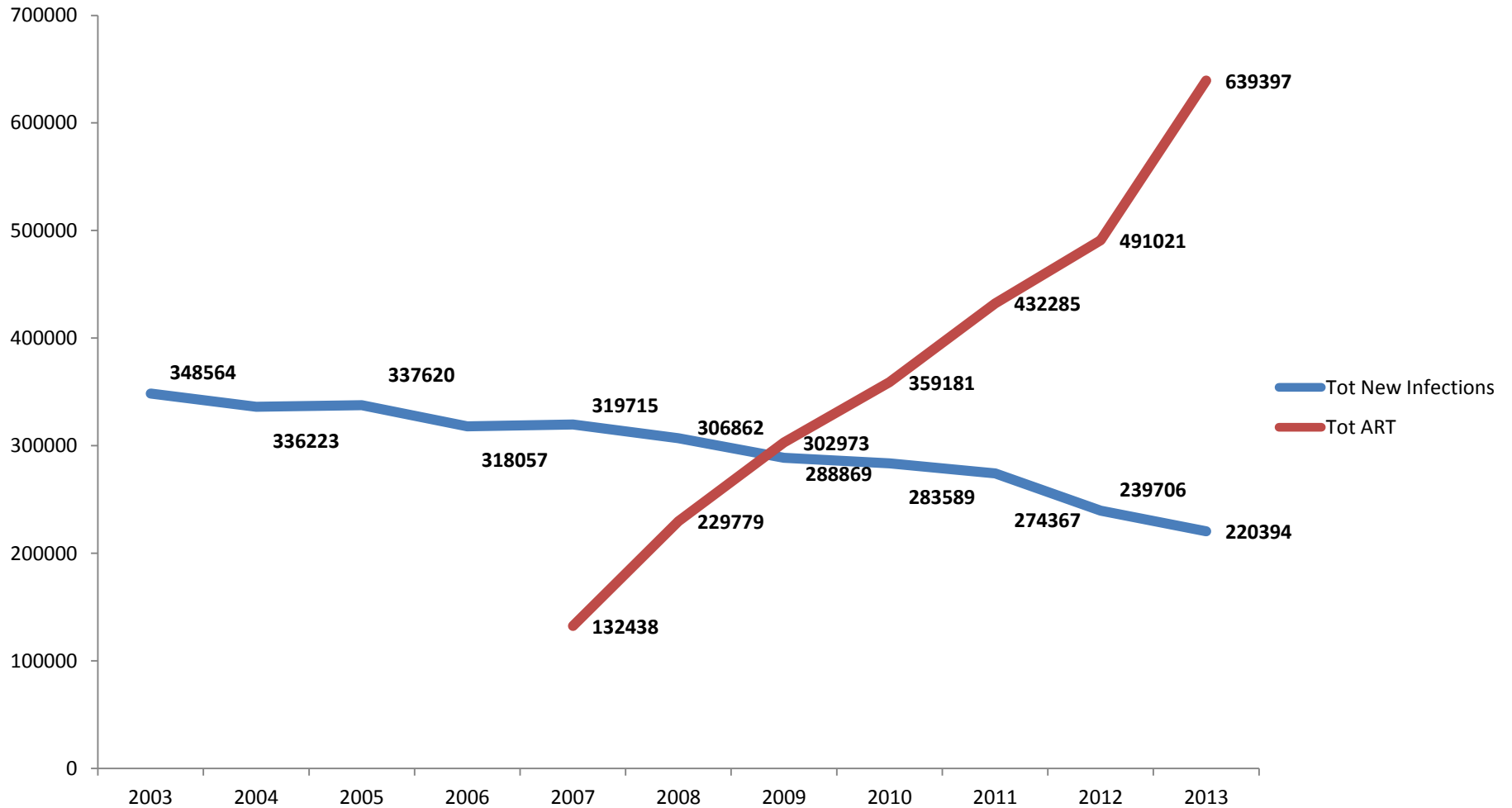
Number of PLHIV on ART : 2007-2013



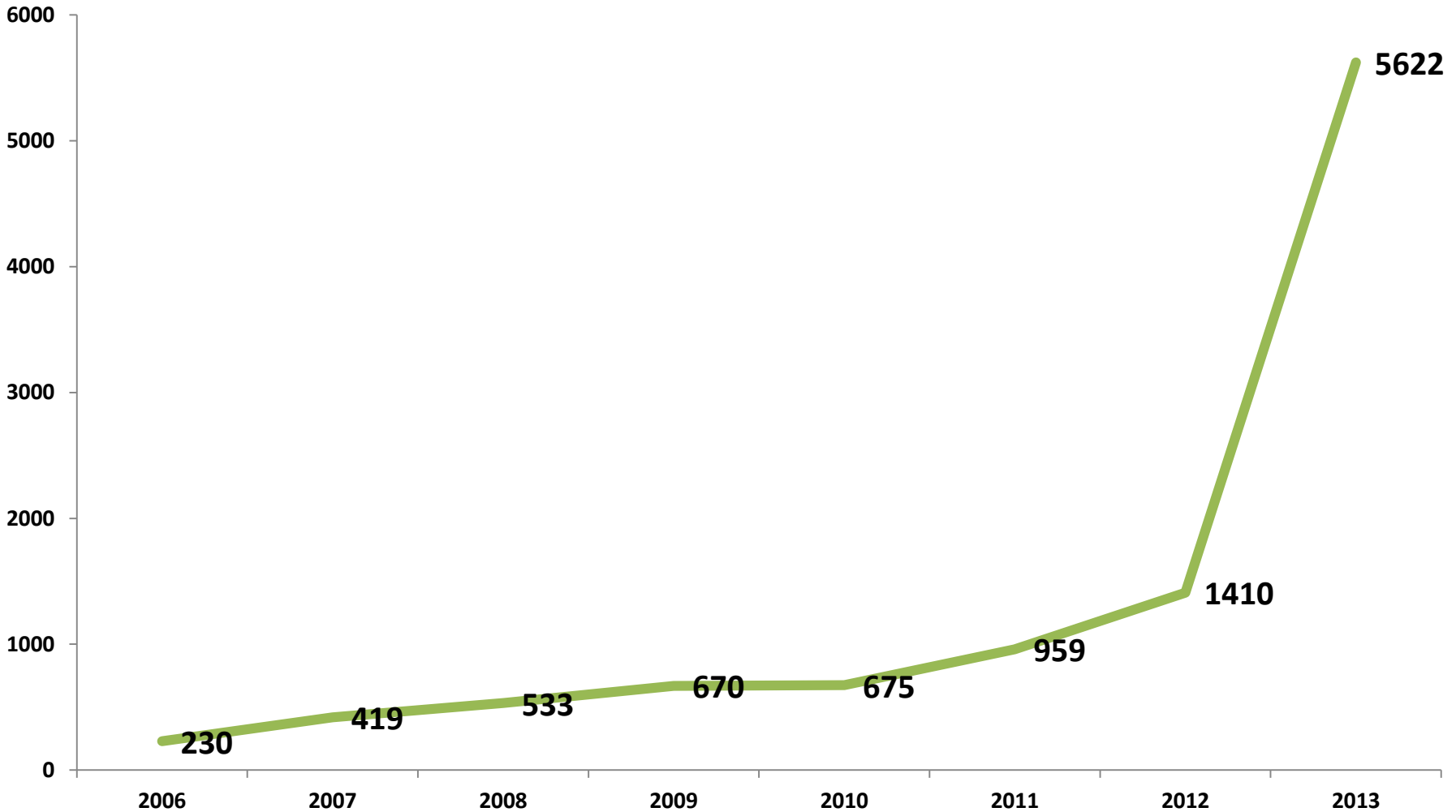
ART Coverage: 2010 vs 2013



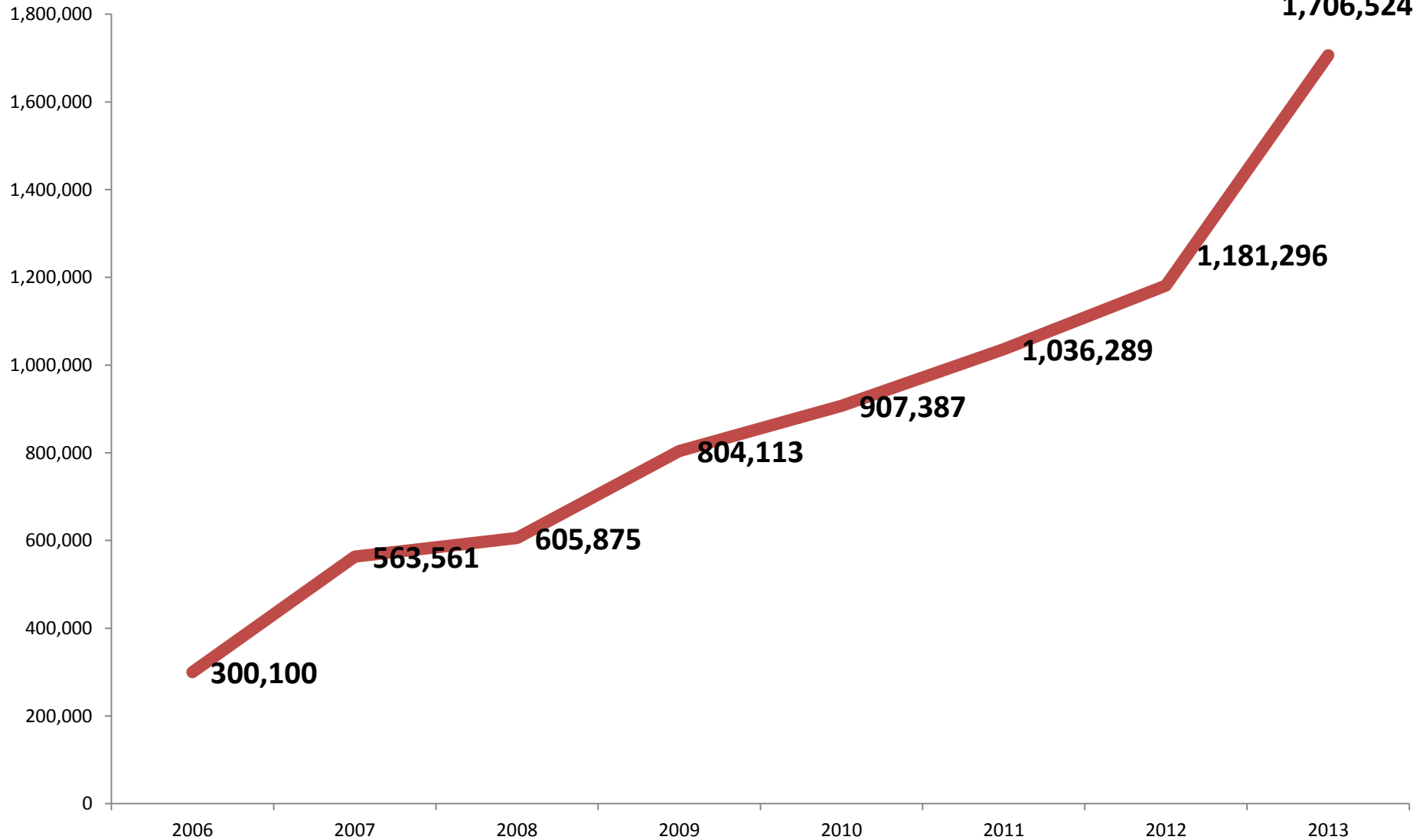
New HIV Infections versus Number of PLHIV on ART : 2007-2013



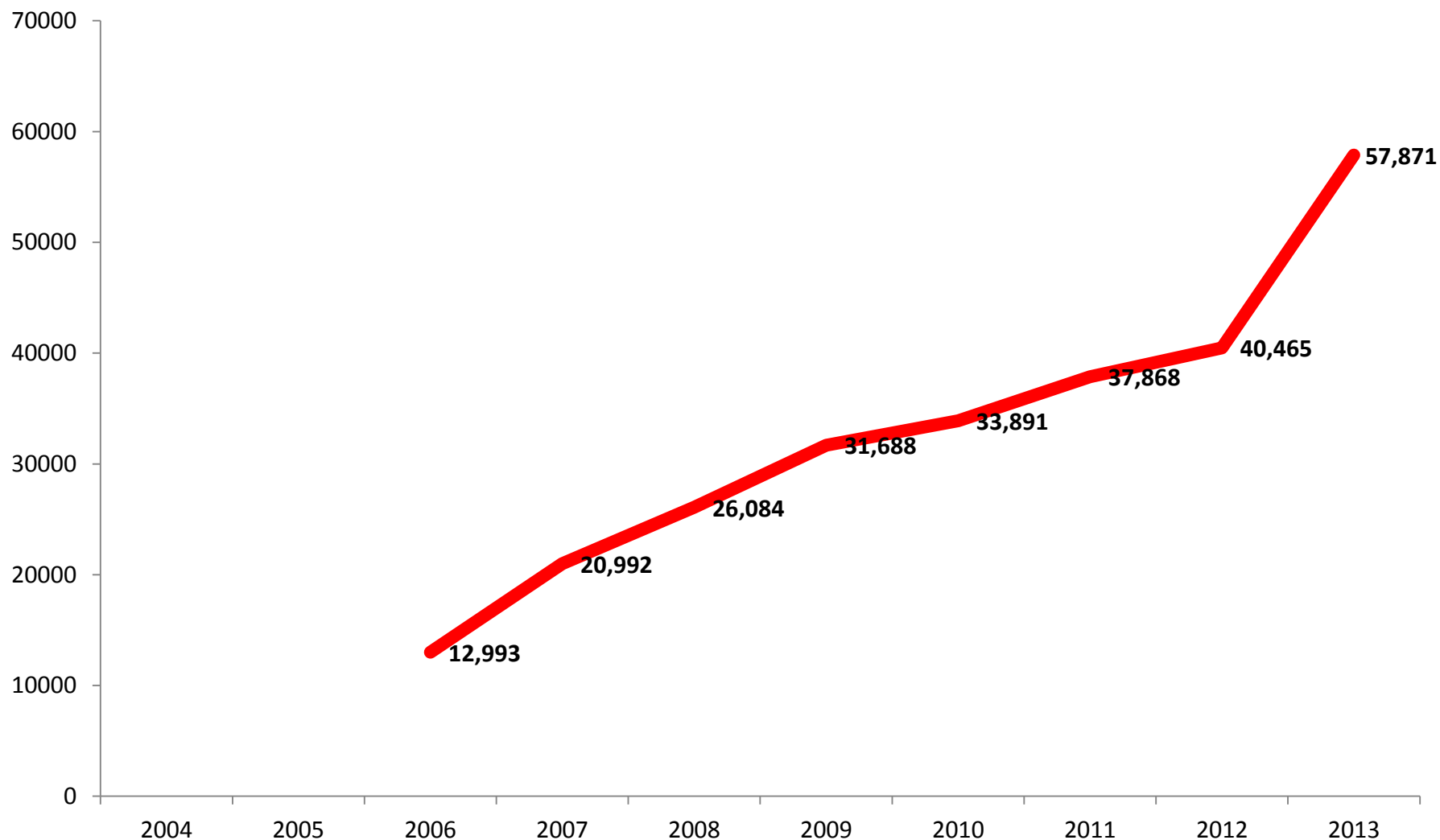
Number of PMTCT Sites in Nigeria 2006-2013



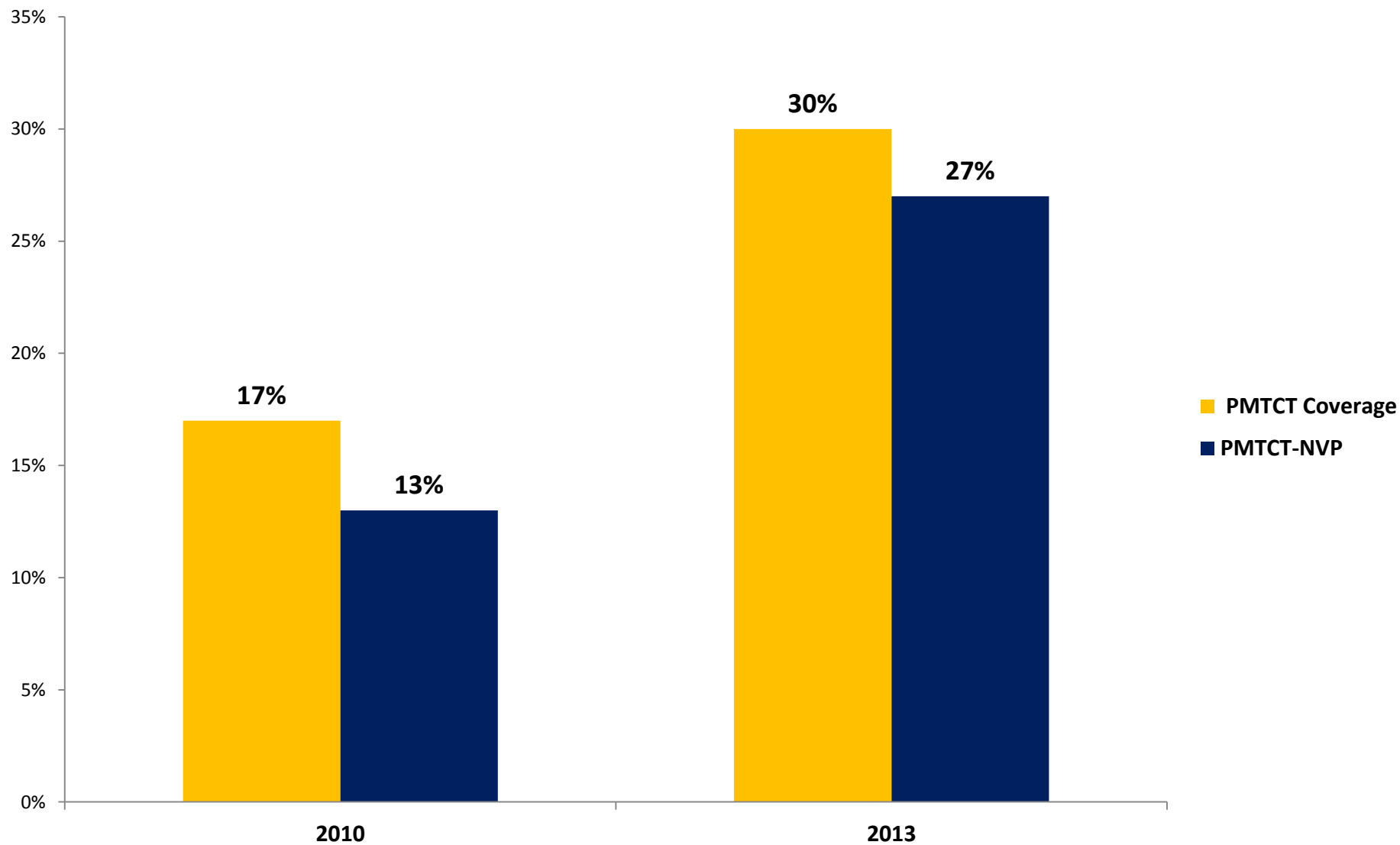
Number of pregnant women who were counselled, tested and received results



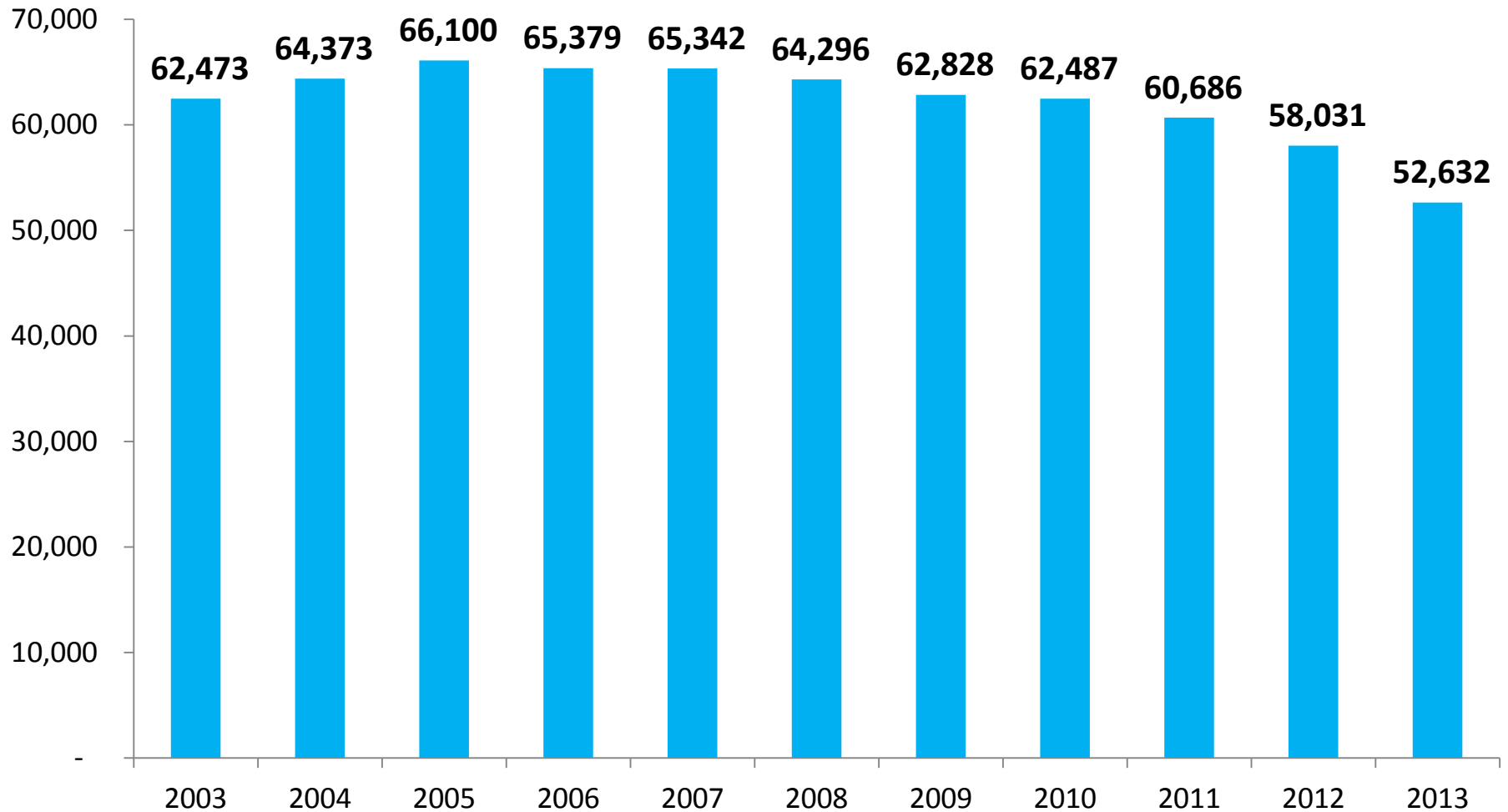
Number of HIV+ Pregnant Women on ART for PMTCT: 2006-2013
